To Whom it may Concern:

My name is Debra Phillips and I am writing on my behalf to appeal indictment 2009-GS-02-1500. I do not deny my guilt in the crime as I did plea guilty voluntarily. However, I would like to appeal my sentence.

During my sentencing hearing the judge asked about my cooperation, if any, to the state. The solicitor did not offer to the judge, nor did my attorney (Barry Thompson II), any information regarding my willingness to help the state against my co-defendants.

After my arrest I did obtain and submit to the solicitor's office an audio tape of my co-defendant confessing to the crime and his part in it. When I spoke to my attorney, after I had been sentenced, and asked why that information wasn't provided to the judge I was told that he was never told of the tape nor was he provided a copy of the tape.
