



4. In November of 2015, Ms. Hackett informed Appellant that his appendix was over 2,500 pages (two thousand five hundred).
5. Due to her heavy case-load, Ms. Hackett lacks the time that is necessary to give Appellant's case the proper attention, which will result in prejudice against the Appellant and will have a harmful or negative outcome of the case.
6. Any mistake(s) Appellate Counsel makes in determining viable issues for briefing cannot be resolved on post-conviction relief.
7. This Motion is not untimely because Appellate Counsel has not filed any briefs on Appellant's behalf.
8. This is not a death penalty case.
9. The Appellant is knowledgeable of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedures and he has filed pro se briefs in his post-conviction relief procedures. (See attachments #'s 1, 2, 3, and 4).
10. (See) STATE v. ROBERTS, 364 S.C. 583, 614 S.E. 2d 626 (S.C. 2005).

Wherefore, Appellant prays that this Honorable Court grants this motion and relieves Susan B. Hackett, Esquire, from his case, and allows him to proceed Pro Se.
