The reason for the Appeal is do to the fact that we were not given a court date to return to court as Judge Nicholson stated and recorded on January 12, 2015. Judge Nicholson stated and recorded that when we return to court that I should have all of the necessary documentations. We continuously contacted the Clerk of Courts for a date to return back to court and each every time we were told one has not been set and to continue to check the roster, we were never told that the case was dismissed. We never recieved a court date and /or a letter from the Berkeley County Clerk of Courts nor from Judge Nicholson, that case number 11-CP-08-2631 was dismissed. When we called SAIC attorney Ms. Cuttino, is when we all received copies of a letter from Ms. Cuttino herself stating that the case was dismissed, with Judge Nicholson signature on the bottom, and not stamped with a seal. Till today we have not received that letter from the Berkeley County Clerk of Courts, nor from Judge Nicholson. SAIC lawyers settled with seven of the plaintiffs, and not the five who came to court on the 12th of January 2015. The names are me (Sebrina Walker), Lois Parker, Gloria Sinsuat, Rev.Elizabeth Sharper, and Ann Nicholson. We were dropped by our lawyers who represented all of us. They cannot settle with some plaintiffs and not all when we all filed together and for the same exact reasons. We were done wrong. There were no lawyers who would take our case, and all of the attorneys we contacted said this case was a mess and it was too late into the case for them to represent us. It seems that we were wrongfully dismissed because we were ProSe. I would like for the Courts of Appeal to allow me and those who are part of this case, the fair chance to represent ourselves and allow us the court date that was never given to us, when Judge Nicholson annouced that we would return on another court date.

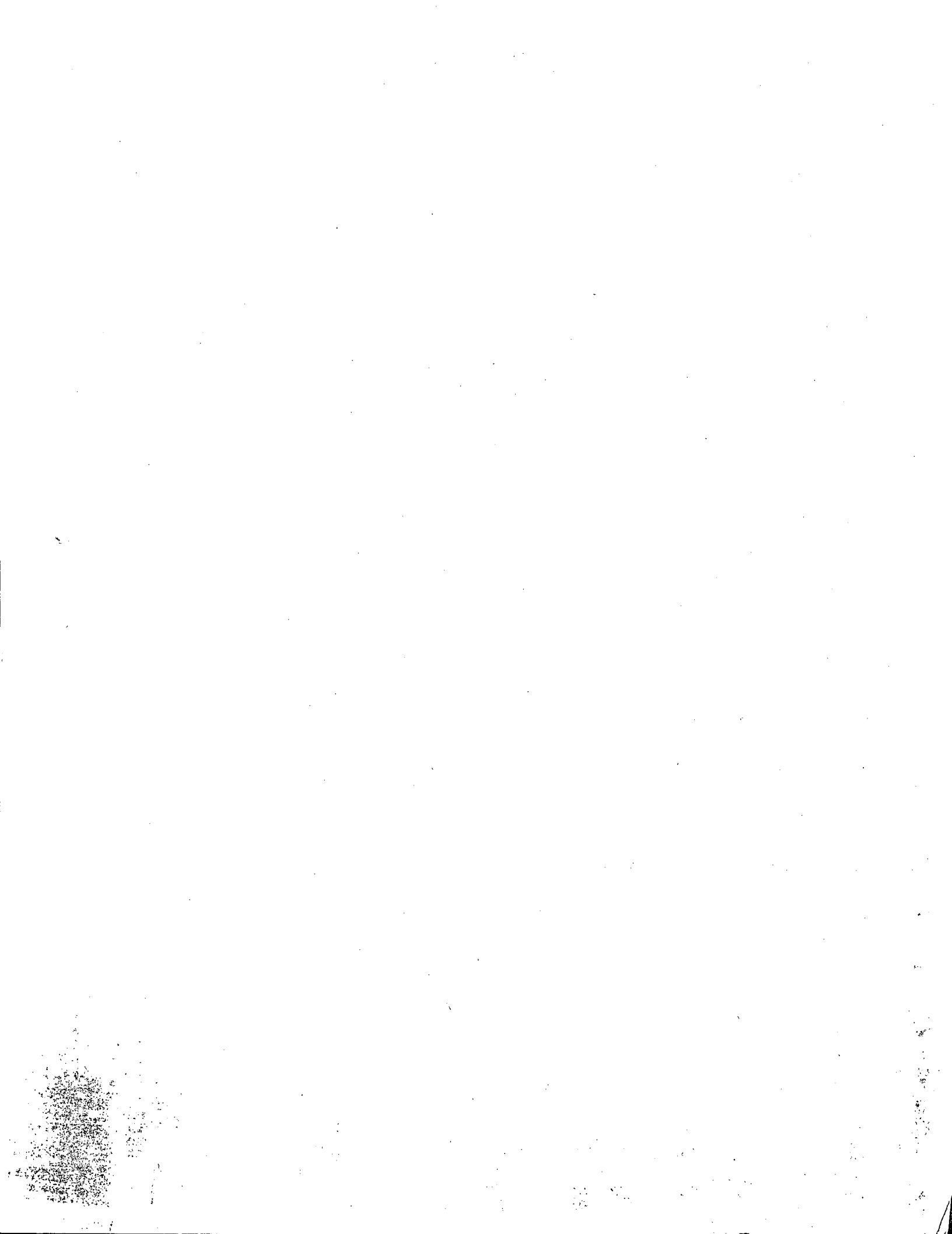

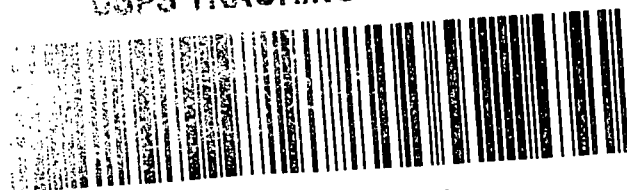
