

## ORDER

---

Petitioner moves to strike the arguments raised as "additional sustaining grounds" by respondent in his Return to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari. The motion is denied. Within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, petitioner shall serve and file a supplemental petition including arguments as to whether respondent's additional sustaining grounds are preserved for appellate review and whether those grounds have merit. Respondent shall, within thirty (30) days of service of the amended petition, file a supplemental return addressing the preservation question and the merits of his additional sustaining grounds.
