MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME


1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Perry B. Buchanan respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. On November 23, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Randall Wade McCoy with the Court of Appeals. On November 12, 2015, counsel filed a petition for rehearing in State v. Don-Survi Chisolm with the Court of Appeals. On November 10, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Detrick Walker v. State with this Court. On November 6, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Saire Castro v. State with this Court. On November 4, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. London A. Kelley with the Court of Appeals. On October 26, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Stepheno Jermaine Alston with this Court. On October 22, 2015, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Montez Barker v. State with this Court. On October 14, 2015, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Ricky L. Hayes with the Court of Appeals.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.






