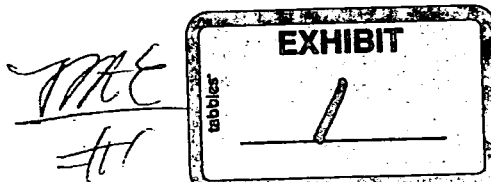
To assist in the efficient management of this case, the Court hereby enters the following Scheduling Order that shall govern the progress of the above captioned case.


