Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I hope that it is proper for me to send this letter at this time. For reasons complicated by health issues, I am trying to understand when I might be required to work on this appeal or appear for oral argument before the Court. Additionally, I do not know if the Court would like or need the information contained herein for scheduling purposes.

As a pro se Respondent, and a sole practitioner, I feel compelled to advise the Court and opposing counsel of a potential scheduling issue that I may not be able to effectively address later. At some time in the next few months, I expect to be scheduled to receive a stem cell transplant. I have been advised that 90% of such patients are hospitalized for seven (7) weeks after this procedure. The actual timing of the transplant will depend upon when and how my monthly lab results change in the interim. My next lab is on December 9, and labs are scheduled each four (4) weeks thereafter until the decision is made to schedule the transplant.


As a sole practitioner, my concern is that I might be sent correspondence or notice(s) during a time in which I will not be able to handle necessary matters. This concern is compounded by the fact that I have not been served with a Record on Appeal and I do not know the resulting process in such cases.

Accordingly, I respectfully request that the Court please advise me, if possible, of the current status of this appeal and what is next anticipated to happen in this case's appellate process. I also respectfully request the Court take such steps as feasible to work with me concerning scheduling or time deadlines.

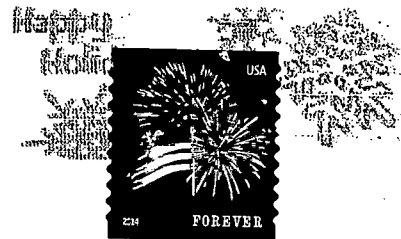
