Dear Mr. Myers:

We have received the last transcript ordered in your case. Enclosed, in the order they will appear in your appendix, are a copy of the October 17, 2011 sentencing transcript, the PCR application, the return, the August 28, 2014 PCR transcript, the May 13, 2015 PCR transcript, the order of dismissal, the SCDC records, and the Georgetown Clerk of Court Records. We have also ordered the PCR exhibits: S-1 (order specifying methods of release), and S-2 (subpoena of Dameon Myers) which will also be included in the appendix, and forwarded to you upon our receipt of them.

The Supreme Court order dated October 21, 2015 states that only those documents before Judge Nettles can be included in the Appendix. Consequently, those are the documents enclosed (with the exception of the two PCR exhibits), and in the order they will appear in the appendix. If you think some other document was before Judge Nettles that is not referenced in this letter, please let our office know within ten days. Otherwise, we will print the appendix in this order given our good faith belief that it is correct.
