
At a Court of General Sessions, convened on July 9, 2015 the Grand Jurors of

**COUNT ONE**  
**ARMED ROBBERY**

That on or about August 16, 2014, in Sumter County, South Carolina, the Defendant, Wilbert J. Franklin Jr., at 660 West Liberty Street, Sumter, South Carolina, by use of force, threats or intimidation and while armed with a deadly weapon, or while alleging, either by action or words, he was armed while using a representation of a deadly weapon or other object which a person present during the commission of the robbery reasonably believed to be a deadly weapon, did take and carry away goods and/or monies from the person or immediate presence of Chaunise Carter, an employee of Kangaroo, with the intent to permanently deprive the victim of possession thereof, in violation of Section 16-11-330(A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
