ORDER

The motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Appellant's motion to reduce the copy requirement due to his status as a pro se inmate is granted. Appellant must still serve Respondent as required by the rules, but he is permitted to file only one copy of his final brief(s) and record on appeal. Appellant must provide a cover page to the record and his brief(s). The covers may be of any material and in any color, and must contain only the caption.
