
As of this date I have not received a response from my communique dated November 20, 2015. As I stated then, the historical rain and flooding in the State of South Carolina caused a state of emergency that was ordered by Governor Haley, and as a result, the Kershaw Correctional Institution was on lock-down for several days with no mail services; no access to the law library; and the modified lock-down also prevent movement to the law library, an mail services that was still limited.

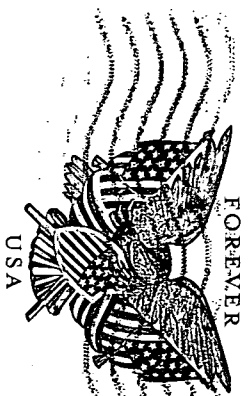

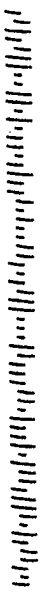

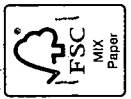
