ORDER

Counsel for the appellant, Orin Briggs, has filed a notice of appeal requesting that the SC Commission on Indigent Defense be appointed to represent the appellant. We deny the request to appoint counsel and construe counsel's request as a motion to be relieved as counsel. Orin Briggs' request to be relieved as counsel is granted. Furthermore, the appellant has previously been prohibited from making any pro se filings in any court of this state absent good cause. *See In the Matter of Marie Assa'ad Faltas*, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated January 30, 2014. Accordingly, the appellant must obtain new counsel, who must appear by January 11, 2016, or this court will dismiss the appeal and send remittitur pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
