Dear Ms. Allen:

By way of additional response to your letter dated December 23, 2015, and in my ongoing attempts to address the discrepancies between the sentencing sheets and the public index, I have contacted the Anderson County Clerk's office. I have spoken to a very helpful young lady named, I believe, Rena Thompson. She remembers that the above case was a trial and not a plea. There were numerous warrants in this trial (upwards of 120 I recollect) and she told me that she is going to go through the public index and try to see if she inadvertently noted that some were by way of guilty plea. She told me this morning that if she had inadvertently made a scrivener's error that she would fix it. I appreciate your bearing with me while I try to fix this matter in the clerk's office. If I need additional time to do this, or if there is something that I am not doing to satisfy your concerns that I should be doing, then I would ask that you give me further instructions and some additional time to satisfy your concerns. I wish to emphasize that in my experience, the Anderson County Clerk's office is extremely well run and very helpful.

I wish to emphasize once again that the above matter went to trial, it was a trial that occurred over 3 separate days, we took all the charges to trial, and most of them were found not guilty. There were no guilty pleas. I was the trial attorney. The case was very well publicized and parts of the trial were on the news in several counties in the upstate and are viewable over the internet right now. There is no question that this case went to trial. I understand that a clerk may have entered some of the information incorrectly in the public index, but I would further submit that public index has never been considered


to be any kind of reliable document. Further, when you access the public index you must certify and sign to the following:

“Neither the county nor any agency, officer, elected official or employee of the county, warrants the accuracy, reliability or timeliness of any information on this web site.....the publication is provided “as is” without warranty of any kind...”

Respectfully, I would submit that the sentencing sheets alone, showing that neither I nor the Defendant signed them, should control in this case.

Once again, thank you for allowing me time to sort this out.
