
**PETITION OF RESPONDENT FOR EXTENSION OF TIME





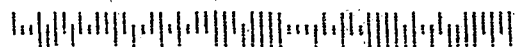
