

Dear Mr. Waters:

The Court has received your motion to proceed in forma pauperis. The appellant's initial brief that was filed with your motion is premature. Please see Rule 208, 209 and 267 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules for the proper time for service and filing, as well as the proper format. Additionally, your motion will not be considered by the Court until the time at which all deficiencies from the order dated December 22, 2015 have been corrected. The following deficiencies remain:

- A notice of appeal containing all information required in Rule 203, SCACR. This includes a statement of when the appellant received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which the appeal is taken.
- A proof of service showing that all parties and the Administrative Law Court were timely served with the notice of appeal. See Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR.
- A copy of the court order being challenged on appeal. See Rule 203(d)(1)(B)(ii), SCACR.
