
**MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME**

The respondent moves for a seven (7) day enlargement of time within which to file and serve the appellant's brief and designation of the record on the following grounds.

The respondent's brief and designation are due to the court this date, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015. Counsel finds himself in need of a modest extension of time within which to complete the appellant's initial brief and designation of the record. Counsel is a sole practitioner with an active trial and appellate practice. 


