Dear Ms. Kitchings:

In the above-referenced appeal, counsel for the State designated State's Exhibit # 1, which is a disc containing a recording of the traffic stop of the appellant, along with State's Exhibit # 3, which is a written rental agreement relevant to the case, for inclusion in the Record on Appeal.

On December 23, 2015, this Court issued an order directing the Darlington County Clerk of Court to release State's Exhibit # 3 (DVD Recording of Traffic Stop) to the South Carolina Attorney General's office for transportation to the Court. However, the order appears to contain a scrivener's error as State's Exhibit # 1 is the recording of the traffic stop instead of State's Exhibit # 3, which is a written exhibit that does not require transportation to the Court.

Accordingly, the State would ask this Court to issue an amended transportation order directing the Darlington County Clerk of Court to release State's Exhibit # 1 (DVD Recording of Traffic Stop) to the South Carolina Attorney General's office for transportation to the Court, and a proposed transportation order is attached to this letter.
