Dear Mr. Moore:

I received your letter dated November 12, 2015. I am sorry you are having trouble reaching me by phone. It sounds like the name on the recording does not match the name we have on file for you. You will need to change your recording at the Department of Corrections in order for our system to accept your collect phone calls.

I have not yet started working on your case. I am in the process of compiling the documents to be included in your appendix, including the PCR transcript. I normally send my clients a copy of the appendix at the same time I send them a copy of the petition for writ of certiorari. I do not send a copy of the PCR transcript separate from the appendix.

If there are certain issues from your PCR hearing that you feel strongly about, I suggest that you write to me outlining those issues. When I am working on your case I can review your issues and consider them when deciding what issues should be included in the petition. I hope this addresses your concerns.

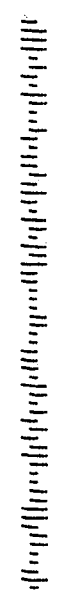

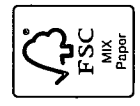
