ORDER

Petitioner has filed a notice of appeal from the denial and dismissal of his seventh application for post-conviction relief (PCR). Petitioner has also submitted the explanation required by Rule 243(c), SCACR. We find petitioner has failed to show there is an arguable basis for asserting the determination by the lower court was improper. Accordingly, we dismiss the notice of appeal in this matter.

Moreover, we hereby prohibit petitioner from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court, including PCR actions and habeas corpus actions, as well as any motions relating to the previously filed collateral actions, challenging indictments 1989-GS-16-696 (armed robbery) and -697 (armed robbery) and the convictions thereon, or any motions in the underlying criminal case, including a motion pursuant to Rule 29, SCRCrimP, without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court.
