Dear Mr. Nash:

We received your filing dated January 3, 2016. In response to your letter, we would like to confirm receipt of the \$100 notice of appeal filing fee after the dismissal of your appeal on July 17, 2014. We construed your filings as a petition for rehearing and reinstated the appeal on September 11, 2014. We subsequently dismissed your appeal a second time for the failure to file an appellant's initial brief that complied with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). We alerted you prior to the second dismissal that your brief must comply with Rules 208 and 209, SCACR. We denied your second petition for rehearing, and issued the remittitur which ended appellate jurisdiction over this appeal. Because we no longer have jurisdiction over your appeal, we cannot take any further action on your filings.
