
**MOTION TO FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AND SERVE THE RECORD ON APPEAL**



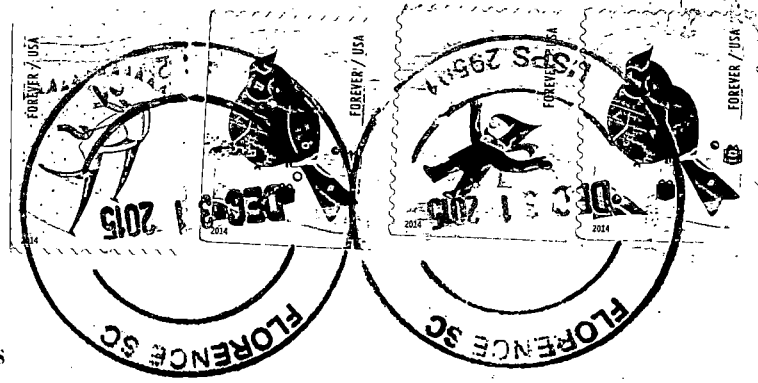
