LEGAL

1 Magistrate This is the preliminary hearing in the matter of the
2 State versus Michael Hilton and Terrence Bradshaw
3 Are you going to do these preliminary hearings
4 together or separately?
5 Mr. McKenzie Your Honor, the factual background is basically the
6 same. I think we can do them together. I would
7 just request permission to question him on behalf of
8 my client's culpability.
9 Magistrate I just wanted to make sure we were clear. What
10 about the reading of the warrants, Mr. Carraway and
11 Mr. McKenzie.
12 Mr. McKenzie Your Honor, I will waive on that right.
13 Mr. Carraway We will waive the reading of the warrant.
14 Magistrate We are ready to proceed in the matter of the State
15 versus Michael Hilton, and I have three warrants. Is
16 it your understanding there are 3 warrants, Mr.
17 McKenzie?
18 Mr. McKenzie Yes, sir.
19 Magistrate The State versus Michael Hilton, H-856425 and
20 State versus Michael Hilton, H-856449, and arrest
21 warrant H-856450. The first charge being murder,
22 the second charge being assault and battery with
23 intent to kill and the third charge being armed
24 robbery while armed with a weapon. In the matter
25 of the State versus Terrence Bradshaw we have three

1. warrants, H-856444, the first charge being murder;
2. the second charge is arrest warrant H-856445,
3. assault and battery with intent to kill, and the third
4. arrest warrant is H-856446, the offense of armed
5. robbery while armed with a weapon. Mr. Sabb, are
6. you ready to proceed?

7. Mr. Sabb I am your Honor.

8. Magistrate If you would, call your first witness.

9. Mr. Sabb We would call Investigator Jerry Gainey.

10. JERRY GAINEY, HAVING been duly sworn,
11. testified as follows:

12. DIRECT EXAMINATION BY MR. SABB:

13. Q You are Investigator Jerry Gainey with the
14. Williamsburg County Sheriff's Department?

15. A Yes, I am.

16. Q And did you have occasion to investigate this
17. incident involving the shooting death of Mr. Louis
18. Henry?

19. A Yes, I did.

20. Q Would you give the court the facts and
21. circumstances surrounding this incident from your
22. understanding.

23. A Yes, on the 25th of December, 2004 in the morning
24. between 2:00 and 3:00 o'clock Benjamin George
25. who is a victim and Louis Henry was at a club at

1 149 Harrison Ned Road in the Greeleyville area.
2 When they were about to leave the club they saw
3 headlights coming towards inside where the
4 business is, and they went back into the club area. ✓
5 The Defendants drove up in the car, one Glen
6 Wilson, along with Michael Hilton, Terrence
7 Bradshaw and Lonell (Lionel) Thompson. Once
8 they approached the club area Benjamin George
9 along with Louis Henry were inside the club, and
10 Mr. Henry was sitting behind the bar area when
11 Michael went inside the club to see who was inside
12 the club, and then he came back out to let Glen
13 Wilson know who was inside. Glen Wilson along
14 with Michael Hilton and Terrence Bradshaw went
15 inside the club. Glen went straight behind where
16 Mr. Louis was asking him for his money. At the time
17 that he went inside Mr. Louis told him the money
18 was outside in the truck. They went out the back
19 door and went around to the truck where they got
20 the bag of money, and then came back inside the
21 club. Mr. Louis tried to tussle with him and Glen
22 Wilson shot him and then he turned and shot
23 Benjamin George also. When they retrieve the
24 money and shot the victims, they left and Mr.
25 Benjamin George crawled over Mr. Louis and made

a phone call to 9-1-1. Once he called and told them he had been shot and needed some police officers down there he said he needed to get off the phone fast because he said that they might come back and try to kill him. That's when an officer arrived on the scene shortly after that, a Sgt. Timmons and Deputy Justin Whack. Once they got there Mr. George was able to talk and he knew the people who went inside the club and shot them. Mr. Glen Wilson was one of the people that he identified along with Michael Hilton. During that time he still was in and out of consciousness and when I got to the hospital where he was, I spoke with him again. He informed me of the people who went inside the club and shot him and Mr. Louis before he was taken to a different hospital.

If you would tell us about your investigation beyond that point and what you did. We understand that Mr. Hilton and Mr. Wilson went inside the club and Mr. Hilton went in first scoping the place out, and went back out, and then he came back with Mr. Wilson and Wilson has the gun, and he committed armed robbery and does the shooting with Hilton there. Tell us about your investigation from that point and where it takes you specifically talking about

1 Bradshaw.

2 A That particular night we were trying to locate Glen
3 Wilson but we were unable to. We got up Terrence
4 Bradshaw, and went to his residence in the
5 Clarendon County area. We went to Clarendon
6 Count and we spoke with someone at the
7 Brewington Road. We went to the residence at 6975
8 S Brewington Road in the Manning area. That is
9 where Terrence Bradshaw lived, and we spoke with
10 his grandmother, and we had a Clarendon County
11 deputy with us and she said that he had not been to
12 the club at all. We told her that we needed to speak
13 to him, and she finally called him and got in contact
14 with him in Summerton. He met us behind the
15 Clarendon County Sheriff's Department, and we
16 advised him then that was not under arrest and asked
17 if he would come with us to Williamsburg County.
18 He stated that yes he would and we asked the driver
19 would he drive him over, but he said he didn't have
20 enough gas. We told him that was no problem, we
21 would go ahead and bring him over here so we could
22 talk to him. We told him he could ride with us and
23 he rode with us over here to the Williamsburg
24 County Sheriff's office. We spoke with him, and he
25 gave us a statement saying who all was involved.

1 He called Glen Wilson's name along with his
2 cousin, Michael Hilton and the he called Lionel's
3 (Lonnell) name. We took him back the following
4 day because he said he did not go inside the club at
5 first and then he said he did go into the club but he
6 did not shoot anybody. He said he was in the pool
7 table area, and that they didn't know that Glen
8 Wilson was going to do what he did. Later after we
9 got back home, he told me to tell his cousin, Michael
10 Hilton to tell the truth, everything will be alright.
11 Later on that night, I received a call that Michael
12 Hilton had turned himself in and they brought him
13 over to the sheriff's office the following day where
14 Lt. Tisdale talked to him about it.

15 Q Part of Mr. Bradshaw's statement did he indicate to
16 you any statement that Mr. Wilson made in terms
17 what had to happen to somebody that night?

18 A Yes, he was saying that when Michael Hilton went
19 inside the club to check the club out and came back
20 out, he said Wilson made the statement somebody's
21 going to have to die tonight. After that Michael
22 Hilton said I've got your back, and so they all went
23 inside the club.

24 Q And after Michael went in and scoped the place out
25 and then Glen went in, Glen was driving when they

- 1 got there, right.
- 2 A Correct.
- 3 Q Who got in the driver's seat when Glen and them
4 went inside to do what they were going to do?
- 5 A Lionel (Lonnell) Thompson.
- 6 Q What did Terrence Bradshaw do when Hilton and
7 Wilson went inside, and Thompson then took the
8 driver's seat, what did Bradshaw do at that point?
- 9 A Bradshaw also was inside, he went inside along with
10 them. He said he was standing at the pool table
11 area.
- 12 Q So he was in there and Hilton was in there, Wilson
13 was in there, and the getaway driver was under the
14 wheel.
- 15 A Yes.
- 16 Q And as I understand it there was an autopsy
17 performed on Mr. Louis Henry's body?
- 18 A Yes.
- 19 Q And the results of the autopsy report are not back,
20 correct?
- 21 A That's correct.
- 22 Q How many times do you understand that Mr. Henry
23 was shot?
- 24 A He was shot 5 times, 4 in the chest and 1 in the head.
- 25 Q How many times do you understand was Mr.

Benjamin George shot?

2 A

He was shot 4 times, 1 in the left shoulder, 1 in the hip area and 2 in the groin.

3

4 Q

And how did Mr. Benjamin George describe for you how he had to behave in order not to be shot more?

5

6 A

He had to act like he was dead, because if he wasn't, they would have killed him.

7

8 Q

Basically he had to lay as still as he possibly could and pretend to not be breathing and all of those things?

9

10

11 A

That's correct.

12 Q

And as we currently are discussing this matter, have all of the Defendants been arrested that are part of this case?

13

14

15 A

Yes, sir.

16 Q

If you would answer any questions that Mr.

17

Carraway or Mr. McKenzie might have for you.

18 CROSS EXAMINATION BY MR. McKENZIE:

19 Q

Investigator, how are you doing?

20 A

Alright.

21 Q

Can you tell me exactly what Mr. George's statement indicated Michael Hilton's involvement was?

22

23

24 A

That he was inside, that he saw him inside the club.

25 Q

Did Mr. George indicate to you in his statement that

1 he felt like Michael was involved in this?

2 A Yes, but he said he didn't do the shooting but he was
3 inside the club along with the others.

4 Q That's a little bit different than what I asked you.
5 Did he indicate in his statement that Michael Hilton
6 was involved in the conspiracy that ultimately ended
7 up in Mr. Henry's death?

8 A He was sitting at the bar.

9 Q Right, and being in the club is one thing, but being
10 involved in what is going on is another:

11 A Right.

12 Q Did Mr. George, who is a victim in this case,
13 indicate in his statement to you that he felt like
14 Michael Hilton or any of these other boys were
15 involved other than Glen Wilson?

16 A The only thing he said to me in his statement was
17 there were three guys that came in, and Glen did the
18 shooting.

19 Q Did he know whether or not Michael was involved?

20 A He knew he was along with Glen Wilson.

21 Q But all he knew was that Michael was there with
22 Glen Wilson?

23 A Yes, they came in together.

24 Q How many statements have been provided in this
25 case?

- 1 A Numerous statements.
- 2 Q And you have a statement from Terrence I believe,
3 don't you.
- 4 A Yes, I do.
- 5 Q And you have one from my client, don't you?
- 6 A Yes.
- 7 Q My client statement says he didn't realize Glen was
8 going to in there and rob the place, is that correct?
- 9 A That is what he said.
- 10 Q And Terrence's statement is basically the same?
11 A Yes, that's what he said.
- 12 Q And how about Lionel?
- 13 A About the same except to the point that when they
14 all went in it was more than one gun.
- 15 Q Did the other gun get brandished, did anybody see
16 the other gun?
- 17 A The only gun that the victim saw was the one that
18 Glen Wilson had.
- 19 Q Has anything come back from SLED regarding the
20 ballistics on the gun?
- 21 A Not yet.
- 22 Q So where do you get the information that Mr. Hilton
23 was the one that went in and scoped the place out to
24 see if anybody was in there?
- 25 A Terrence said that.

1 Q Your understanding is that Terrence gave a
2 statement and said they were all going to go rob this
3 place?

4 A They were outside talking about it in the car when
5 we spoke to Lionel (Lonnell).

6 Q Wait now, so Terrence and Lionel (Lonnell) were in
7 the car together?

8 A They were all in the same car when they drove up
9 together.

10 Q Was there a common plan and design to go and rob
11 this place?

12 A Yes.

13 Q Who told you that?

14 A Terrence Bradshaw along with Lionel (Lonnell).

15 Q Lionel also said that they had planned to rob Louis'
16 place?

17 A Yes.

18 Q And they went to Louis' place with that in mind?

19 A Yes.

20 Q Is that in a written statement?

21 A I would have to check and make sure. I know we
22 talked to them several times.

23 Q Were they recorded, video taped statements.

24 A The statements were recorded and videoed, but we
25 spoke with them before that.

- 1 Q And then you put it down and recorded it and
2 videoed it.
- 3 A Yes, we recorded a statement.
- 4 Q So Terrence and Lionel both gave the same
5 statement in regards that prior to going into Louis'
6 Club in the Greeleyville area that there was a
7 common plan or design to rob the place?
- 8 A They said at first they did not go there to rob the
9 place. They got to the club and Terrence was saying
10 his intention was he was supposed to see a girl there
11 from Williamsburg County, the Greeleyville area.
12 Once they got there they discussed it outside the
13 club.
- 14 Q What did they discuss from your understanding?
- 15 A My understanding was that they were going to go in
16 and rob the place.
- 17 Q Who is they?
- 18 A Glen, along with Michael Hilton, Lionel and
19 Terrence Bradshaw. Who was doing the talking
20 with Glen Wilson.
- 21 Q And that would be on video or a tape recorded
22 conversation you had with them?
- 23 A Should be.
- 24 Q Is it in writing?
- 25 A Yes, I had it transcribed.

1 Q Did Mr. George tell you that he and Michael had a
2 conversation during or prior to the robbery or Mr.
3 prior to Mr. Henry being killed?

4 A Would you repeat that again.

5 Q Mr. Benjamin George, one of the victims, did he
6 inform you that Michael Hilton and he knew each
7 other?

8 A Yes.

9 Q Did he tell you that he and Michael had a
10 conversation whenever Glen came in and shot Mr.
11 Henry?

12 A I can't remember that at this time.

13 Q You can't remember whether or not he told you
14 about that?

15 A No, I can't.

16 Q Can you tell us who went into the club first?

17 A Michael Hilton.

18 Q And then he left the club?

19 A Yes, sir, and then they went back in.

20 Q And they are who?

21 A Glen Wilson, Michael Hilton and Terrence.

22 Q And Lionel is the one who was driving.

23 A He was sitting under the steering wheel when they
24 went inside the club.

25 Q Did any of the Defendants in this case give any

1 indication to you in any of their statements that they
2 were forced to leave the club at gun point by Glen
3 Wilson?

4 A They made a statement to that. I didn't talk to
5 Michael Hilton too much, Lt. Tisdale was talking to
6 him. I was there when he was talking to Terrence
7 Bradshaw, and they stated that they were afraid of
8 him, and he told them if you don't do this, I'll get
9 ya'll too.

10 Q So that was told to the three of them, and when I say
11 three, Michael, Lionel, and this was Glen saying this
12 to Michael and Lionel?

13 A He said it to them when they were in the car.

14 Q Who else supposedly had a gun besides Glen?

15 A I believe Lionel said all three of them went in with a
16 gun.

17 Q And Lionel gave that statement?

18 A Yes, sir.

19 Q And again that would be on video or transcribed?

20 A Yes.

21 Q Did you find any money on any of the Defendants?

22 A No.

23 Q Did Benjamin George relate to you the sequence of
24 events in regards to Michael going in and then
25 leaving?

1 A I can't recall if he told me that or not. I can't
2 remember at this time.

3 Q Have you taken a tape recorded or video from Mr.
4 George?

5 A No, I have not.

6 Q A written statement?

7 A No, I did not.

8 Q The court's indulgence your Honor.

9 Magistrate Certainly.

10 Q No further questions your Honor.

11 Magistrate Mr. Carraway. *Mr McKenzie talk &*

12 Mr. Carraway I have no questions. *Mr Carraway did nothing for me.*

13 Magistrate Mr. Sabb, do you have any other questions.

14 Mr. Sabb I do not your Honor.

15 Magistrate You may step down. Any other witnesses?

16 Mr. Sabb No, sir, judge, that's it.

17 Mr. McKenzie Your Honor, I have no motions at this time. I will be
18 sending out the appropriate Rule 5 discovery, but I
19 would ask the court, and I am sure that Mr. Sabb
20 will cooperate by letting me hear and see the video
21 recording statements given by the Defendants in this
22 case.

23 Mr. Sabb Judge we certainly understand that they have a right
24 to see them, and we intend to comply with the Rules
25 throughout the process.

1 Mr. McKenzie

Thank you your Honor.

2 Magistrate

3 The court does find probable cause on all three
4 charges on each, Mr. Michael Hilton, charged with
5 murder, and also on Mr. Terrence Bradshaw the
6 court does find probable cause on all three of these
7 charges. Each person is charged with three charges,
8 murder, assault and battery with intent to kill and
9 armed robbery while armed with a weapon, and they
will be sent up.
