ORDER

Respondent has filed a "Motion to Allow Filing on November 6, 2015 and Allow Filing As Is." Respondent's request to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter out of time is granted. However, Respondent's request to file the brief "as is" is denied. Respondent's brief, which totals eighty-eight pages, exceeds the page limit for its initial brief as set forth in Rule 208(b)(5) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. After careful review of the parties' filings, we find the issues raised on appeal do not demand a brief of this length. However, Respondent may file an amended brief totaling no more than seventy-five pages in length. Respondent has thirty days to serve and file the amended brief, and Appellant's reply brief shall be due ten days thereafter.
