

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on October 31, 2013 , the Grand Jurors of Beaufort County present upon their oath:

Murder / Murder

That in Beaufort County on or about July 31, 2013, with malice aforethought, Walter Glass did kill and murder Melanie Lowther. To wit: he struck her repeatedly over the head with a blunt object and stabbed her with a sharp object in the mid section, and that Melanie Lowther did die in Beaufort County as a proximate result thereof on July 31, 2013; in violation of Section 16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976), as amended.
