We are in receipt of the Appellate Court's letter dated December 14, 2015, regarding your motion for enlargement of time to file Respondent's initial brief (copy enclosed). Please be advised that Appellant South Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (SCDMV) has not received a copy of your motion for enlargement of time to file Respondent's initial brief.

It has come to our attention that all filings by your office have been significantly delayed in receipt by SCDMV. For instance, the Proof of Service for Respondent's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter was dated November 9, 2015, however, was not received by SCDMV until November 13, 2015. 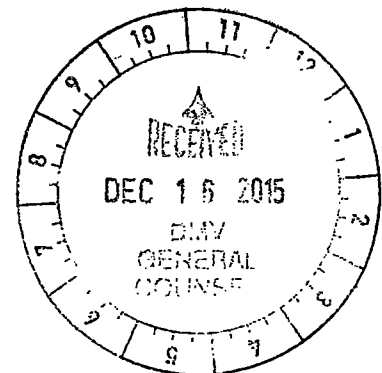
- According to our records, Anna D. Wilson is the respondent in this appeal. You must file an amended motion for enlargement of time.

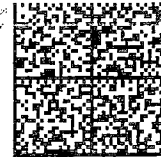
