At a Court of General Sessions, convened on _____, the Grand Jurors of Spartanburg County present upon their oath:

ARMED ROBBERY

That the Defendant, Randy Glenn, did in Spartanburg County, on or about April 7, 2015, while armed with a pistol, dirk, slingshot, metal knuckles, razor, knife or other deadly weapon or while alleging, either by actions or word, he was armed while using a representation of a deadly weapon or any object which a person present during the commission of the robbery reasonably believed to be a deadly weapon feloniously take from the person or presence of Family Dollar and/or Tiffany Lee Jolley, by means of force or intimidation goods or monies of Family Dollar and/or Tiffany Lee Jolley, described as follows: US currency and/or cigarettes, with intent to deprive the owner permanently of such property, in violation of Section 16-11-330 (A), Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976, as amended).
