
Dear Mr. Green:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, the proof of service must name the specific document that you have served and must include the name and mailing address of the party you have served.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption on the notice of appeal must include the name of the judge and the number from the lower court.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.

- The notice of appeal must include a statement from you indicating the date that you received notice that the order you are appealing was filed with the clerk of court in Marlboro County.
