
FELONY DUI – GREAT BODILY INJURY

That the Defendant, Tony Lee McEntire, did in Spartanburg County on or about November 19, 2014 drive a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or a combination of alcohol and drugs, and violated an act forbidden by law or neglected any duty imposed by law in the driving of the vehicle, to-wit:

- (1) Failure to maintain proper control of vehicle, and/or
- (2) Failure to follow right of way restrictions (Art 17, Section 56) and/or
- (3) Reckless Driving (Section 56-5-2920) and/or
- (4) Driver's failure to exercise due care and/or
- (5) Failure to maintain a proper lookout for other traffic and/or pedestrians.

Which proximately caused Great Bodily Injury to Taylor Crosby, in violation of §56-05-2945 (A) (1), of *THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA*, (1976), as amended.
