Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title represented on the notice of appeal does not match that on the orders presented. You will need to file a copy of an order or complaint which shows the same caption as you have shown on the notice of appeal. For example, the September 25, 2014, order shows "Concord & Cumberland, LLC, et al., Defendants." Also, that same order stops with "...And Pamela L. Vaughn, Plaintiffs. Whereas the caption on the notice of appeal continues with a number of additional plaintiffs.
