MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for William Zeigler respectfully requests a **fourth and final** extension of thirty (30) **until February 29, 2016**, days in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for William Zeigler respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Quentin Evans with the Court of Appeals on January 29, 2016. Counsel filed petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Edward Clarkson v. State with the Supreme Court on January 20, 2016. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Alicia Adderly with the Court of Appeals on January 13, 2016. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. William Bolt with the Supreme Court on January 7, 2016. Counsel filed a return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of State v. Brandon Garren with the Supreme Court on January 7, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Kadrin Singleton with the Court of Appeals on January 6, 2016. Counsel filed petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of William Whitfield v. State with the Supreme Court on January 6, 2016. Along with co-counsel Chief Appellate Defender Robert M. Dudek, on December 31, 2015, counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the Supreme Court in the capital case of State v. Ricky Blackwell. Counsel filed petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Supreme Ackbar v. State with the Supreme Court on December 11, 2015. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Tykeem May with the Court of Appeals on December 10, 2015. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Lamar Brown with the Supreme Court on November 30, 2015.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.




