Dear Mr. Brown:

In compliance with the Court's order issued today, holding all timelines in this case in abeyance pending the resolution of your motion for relief, we are returning your record on appeal and appellant's final brief to you. For your convenience, we will list the deficiencies noted on these filings so that you can have an opportunity to correct them prior to their resubmission at the proper time. They include:

Attorney Temus C. Miles has filed a notice of appearance to represent the respondent. You will need to add his information to the cover of the record on appeal.

Pursuant to Rule 210(g) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, SCACR, you will need to revise your certificate of counsel to "certify that the Record on Appeal contains all material proposed to be included by any of the parties and not any other material."

The required certificate of counsel for the final brief (missing from your submission) must state that your "final brief complies with Rule 211(b)."

The proof of service may not be attached to the front of the record on appeal or the final brief. You may provide it with the unbound original copies or attach it to the back of the copies.

You are required to follow the guidance of Rule 267, SCACR, regarding the paper required for submission of the record on appeal and for the final brief. They must be properly bound - except for the original, of proper paper weight, and be the correct color. The record on appeal has white covers. The appellant's final brief must have blue covers.
