ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on March 4, 2015. No petition for rehearing was filed, and this Court sent down the remittitur on March 20, 2015. Appellant has now filed a motion requesting that this court recall the remittitur and reinstate the appeal. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence *on the part of this Court or its officer.*" *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893) (emphasis added). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because Appellant failed to timely file a petition for rehearing with this Court, remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.
