Please be advised that Mr. Brown has filed a *pro se* notice of appeal from the final order dated June 28, 2012, and filed with the clerk of the circuit court on July 5, 2012. The notice of appeal is dated September 6, 2012, and the proof of service indicates that it was served on the counsel for the State on September 6, 2012.

Since you were his counsel below, I remind you that you continue to be his counsel of record in this matter. Further, if he is indigent, you must assist him "in obtaining representation by the Division of Appellate Defense of the Office of Indigent Defense." Rule 71.1(g) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure.

To determine the timeliness of the service of the notice of appeal, it will be necessary for you to advise this office of the date that you received written notice of entry of the final order dated June 28, 2012. This information must be provided within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.

All parties to this matter are advised that this case has been assigned the appellate case number that appears above. Please use this number on all future correspondence relating to this matter.

Further, all filings made in this matter must comply with the requirements of Rule 267 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). The SCACR is available online at www.sccourts.org/courtreg. Additionally, any filings submitted by counsel admitted in South Carolina must include counsel's bar number.

The attention of the parties is directed to the order relating to the inclusion of personal data identifiers and other sensitive information in documents filed with the Supreme Court of South Carolina and the South Carolina Court of Appeals.
