ORDER

First, Appellant's request for an extension of time to serve and file his initial brief and some motions is granted. Appellant shall serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter within thirty days of the date of this order.

Second, Appellant's request to relax the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules copy requirements is granted. Appellant must still serve Respondent as required by the rules, but he is permitted to file only one copy of his initial brief, reply brief (if any), final brief(s), and record on appeal with this court. Moreover, Appellant must provide a cover page to the record and his brief(s). The covers may be of any material and in any color, and must contain only the caption.

Third, Appellant's "motion to remand for evidentiary hearing on second 59(e) motion" is denied.

Finally, Appellant's motion to remand to reconstruct the record of his January 2008 evidentiary hearing on his Rule 60(b) motion is denied.
