ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING DECISION BY THE COURT AS REFERENCED ON PAGE 1.

This action came to trial or hearing before the court. The issues have been tried or heard and a decision rendered.

The jury finds by unanimous consent that John Crane, Inc was NOT negligent and it was not a proximate cause of the plaintiff's injuries and damages and the Defendant John Crane, Inc is hereby Dismissed from this action.

The jury finds by a unanimous consent that Celanese was negligent and its negligence was a proximate cause of the plaintiff's injuries and damages. \$2,000,000 actual damages for the Survival action \$5,000,000 actual damages for the Wrongful Death action \$5,000,000 actual damages for the Loss of Consortium action

The Jury Finds by unanimous consent clear and convincing evidence that Celanese was willful, wanton, or reckless. As to Plaintiffs' claims against Celanese for punitive damages the jury by unanimous consent finds by clear and convincing evidence for Plaintiffs in the amount of \$2,000,000 punitive damages.
