ORDER

On December 2, 2015, this court ordered Appellant to serve and file an amended record on appeal that includes all documents listed in the parties' designations of matter that were presented to the circuit court and excludes all documents that were not listed in the parties' designations of matter. Appellant has served and filed an amended record on appeal, and Respondent has filed a second motion to dismiss this appeal.

In the motion to dismiss, Respondent alleges Appellant's amended record includes documents not presented to the circuit or not included in the parties' designations of matter.¹ In addition, Respondent argues that Appellant failed to include two documents in the record that were designated by Respondent— Defendant's answer filed August 12, 2014, and the certificate of service for the answer. Finally, Respondent asserts Appellant included various copies of several documents in the record on appeal.

Appellant shall serve and file a second amended record on appeal by noon on February 15, 2016. The second amended record shall include only one copy of each of the documents listed in the parties' designations of matter; shall include Defendant's answer filed August 12, 2014, and the certificate of service for the answer; and shall not include any document that was not listed in the parties'

designations of matter or was not presented to the circuit court. This court will consider the motions to dismiss upon receipt of the second amended record or on February 15, 2016.
