
Re: Your Appeal

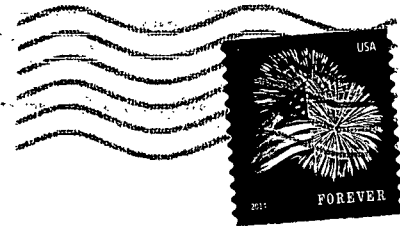
