to make a mistake

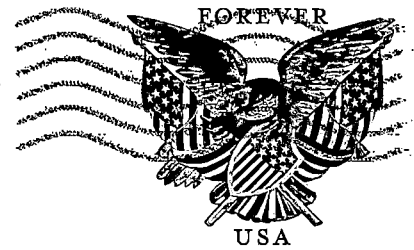
The question people want to know is why I

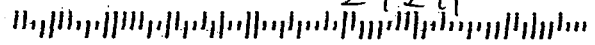
