

I estimate that the transcript will consist of approximately 75 pages. Therefore, I will require an advance deposit of \$250.00 to place your request in line for transcription, sent to me at the address listed below. Please note that this is only an estimate. Similarly, if the final cost is less than the deposit amount, I will refund the overage to you.

Additionally, please further define your request in terms of transcript format (paper copy via U.S. Mail, electronic copy via e-mail, etc.), and the turnaround time you are seeking, as there are additional fees for additional services as set forth in SCACR Rule 607(h)(1)(J). Normal turnaround time for transcripts is 60 days unless otherwise specified and agreed to for expedited service. ?There are three different expedited rates and turnaround times: seven-day, one-day, and same-day service. ?

In accordance with the court reporter manual approved by the Supreme Court of South Carolina, the due date will be determined by the date I receive your advance payment.
