did within this County and State on the 11th day of March 2014 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE
Attempted Murder

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on March 11, 2014 at approximately 8:15PM, while at the Dorchester Gardens Apartments, which is located in the City of North Charleston, County of Charleston, State of South Carolina, the defendant **Laquan Damon Bryan**, did commit the offense of **Attempted Murder**, in violation of section **16-3-29** of the South Carolina Code of Laws of 1976, as amended. In that the defendant while armed with a handgun did shoot at the victim at least three (3) times with the intent to cause serious bodily injury.

Facts to establish the aforesaid are that the victim was working at the above location when he observed a disturbance between three (3) black males, which included the defendant, and one (1) black female, the defendant's mother, near the 700 building. During this disturbance the victim requested that the males leave the property, at which time they continued causing a disturbance. After several minutes the property manager called police for assistance, at which time the males entered into a dark in color Jeep grand Cherokee bearing South Carolina plate #JLQ147 and began to leave the complex. As the vehicle pulled away the victim attempted to obtain the above plate number at the request of the emergency dispatcher. As he walked behind the vehicle the driver exited and began a physical disturbance. During this disturbance the defendant exited from the front passenger door of the vehicle while armed with a .32 Caliber revolver, approached the victim, pointed and fired approximately three (3) shots at the defendant who jumped into a nearby ditch. The defendant and driver then re-entered the vehicle and fled. A traffic stop was later conducted on this vehicle, at which time the defendant was occupying the front passenger seat. During a post-Miranda interview the defendant confessed to the above facts. The victim and a witness positively identified the defendant as the shooter from a photographic array lineup. Det. Repman, the victim and witnesses to be named later in court are witnesses to prove the same. All done against the law, peace and dignity of the State of South Carolina.
