Dear Mr. Kamini:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service does not include the date the brief was served on the opposing party.
- You have included attachments to your initial brief. These attachments are not permitted and are being returned to you. The initial brief must be accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. Your initial brief will not be accepted without a designation of matter. See Rule 209, SCACR, for guidance.
- The content of your initial brief should be double-spaced and not single spaced. See Rules 208 and 267, SCACR, for guidance.
- You must provide written confirmation of the date you received the transcript from the court reporter so that filing deadlines may be calculated.

- The caption on the brief is incorrect. The correct caption for this appeal should read as follows:

Thomas Campbell, Respondent,

v.

Cyrus Kamini and Heideh Larijani, Defendants,

Of whom Cyrus Kamini is the Appellant.
