ORDER

In this post-conviction relief (PCR) case, the South Carolina Court of Appeals denied the petition for a writ of certiorari. Petitioner has now filed a motion seeking an extension of time to serve and file the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix to review this decision of the Court of Appeals. Since this Court has held that it will not review the denial of a petition for a writ of certiorari by the Court of Appeals in a PCR case, the motion for an extension is denied. *Ellison v. State*, 382 S.C. 189, 676 S.E.2d 671 (2009).
