 6. WHEREFORE, I pray the court order to the prison to follow it's own rules in order to provide meaningful access to THIS court.

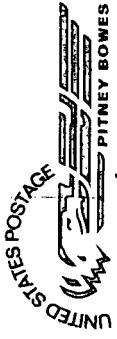
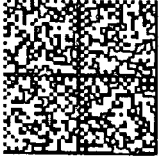
