Upon reviewing your amended notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, we have received the order signed November 23, 2015. However, if this is the order you are appealing, you must specifically state this on your notice of appeal as well as stating the date on which you received a copy of the order.
- Your letter states that you should not have to pay any filing fees. If you would like the Court to consider a motion to proceed in forma pauperis you must file a motion with the Court, including a proof of service.
- You must provide a proof of service stating the date on which you originally served the notice of appeal.
