
CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Appellant South Carolina Coastal Conservation League ("SCCCL"), by and through its undersigned counsel and with the consent of the Respondents South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control and Oakridge Landfill, Inc. ("Respondents") (collectively, SCCCL and Respondents hereinafter referred to as "Parties"), respectfully moves this Court for a 180-day extension of the deadline to file and serve its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. On December 21, 2015, this Court issued an Order holding these deadlines in abeyance for a period of 60 days from the date of the Order. Accordingly, the current deadline is February 19, 2016. SCCCL requests a 180-day extension to August 17,

2016, of the deadline to file and serve its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.

The grounds for this motion are that the Parties have reached a settlement in principle to resolve the matters at issue in this appeal. However, the settlement is contingent on certain approvals from the United States Army Corps of Engineers ("Corps") and South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control ("DHEC"). SCCCL and Oakridge Landfill, Inc. have met with the Corps regarding the approvals required under the settlement, and as a result of that meeting have proceeded to develop an alternative mitigation plan for submittal to the Corps and DHEC. Upon review and approval of the alternative mitigation plan, the parties expect that such approvals will be issued. The Parties anticipate that these approvals can be obtained within 180 days.

WHEREFORE, SCCCL, with the consent of Respondents, respectfully requests an order granting a 180-day extension to August 17, 2016, for SCCCL to and serve its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.



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
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
