

I'm being fought hard, because of my Civil Rights, I'm being Fought Hard because of my Constitutional Rights, The days for difference of receiving Justice is no longer a point where I cannot fight. Those who, of my origins, who feel that they have made it in South Carolina, need to remember and understand the indifference in this State.

I thank you, the Courts, for giving me the guidance to share my views from laws that was used as well words that I have written.

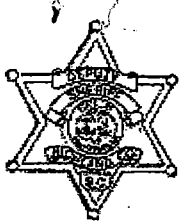
