Motion to Reinstate

Appellant Pro se, Jack Powell hereby submits this Motion to Vacate the Dismissal that was filed by the South Carolina Court of Appeals and remitted to the lower Court on on Nov. 18th, 2016 because the Clerks Office made the mistake of not filing & posting mailed documents concerning this Appeal while simultaneously exercising the same pattern of mistakes during 2 other cases 2015-001331 & 2015-000049. Appellant has submitted multiple mistakes of this pattern and files this Motion Pursuant Rule 59 (e) and because of the exception to the Motion to Reinstate rule to be filed within a reasonable time when the Remittitur is sent down by mistakes, or inadvertence of the Court, Keels Supra. Therefore Appellant submits the following ongoing pattern of mistakes.

1. Originally the Appellant mailed a letter to the Court of Administration/Clerks Office about his concern of mailed documents not being filed with the Court and posted

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and the Clerks Office did not respond to the documented proof about this concern. Appellant had asked the Clerks Office what legal and/or procedure can a Pro se take or was there something that the Clerks Office needed to do to fix the problem, please respond and there was no response.

2. On Oct. 1st. 2015 Appellant purchased a money order and 2 stamps and mailed to the Court of Administration and to Attorney's Wall, Templeton and Haldrup for a Motion to Proceed Out of Time (Exhibit A, this case 2015-000049) which included Appellants Designation of Matter and the Appellants USPS receipt was noted for personal records that it was mailed that day.

3. On Oct. 13, 2015 Appellant mailed a letter (Exhibit B, cases 2015-000049, 2015-001331 & 2015-001511) containing 3 letters of the same concern, was accompanied by 3 proofs of service to all parties and they were never posted. Again, Appellant assumes this was a mistake and there was no response after requesting the Clerks Office to let Appellant know what had happened and what could be done concerning these mistakes.

4. These 3 letters of concern were never properly posted and these cases were dismissed because of the mistakes made by the Clerks Office. The noted USPS receipt references the Transcript and the Court reporter which was a Form letter that was intended for Appeal 2015-001331 notifying the Court of Administration the Transcript has not been received and there was an improper monetary request (Exhibit G) and this also wasn't properly posted by the Clerks Office.

5. Also on Oct. 13th Appellant called about his Designation of Matter concerning this case that was mailed on Oct. 1st 2015 and also enclosed was a \$25 USPS money

order. Appellant wanted to inquire why it wasn't posted and he was told that Elizabeth Carter whom handled Appellants cases wasn't there, so another lady said she would help and she didn't identify herself. Appellant asked why they weren't posted and she asked Appellant to hold on for a minute and then she got back on the phone and was basically thinking out loud and said no, no, here it is and it was found by someone who wasn't Appellants personal handler of his cases. It was posted that day, the 13th and of course it was signed on Oct 1st 2015, stamped by the USPS that it was mailed on Oct. 1st.

6. On Oct. 22nd a Deficiency letter was sent stating Appellant did not sign his Motion to Reinstate & the Proof of Service and he had 10 days to return or the Remittitur would be sent. (Exhibit C) Appellant mailed with his signatures on Oct. 31st which was within the 10 days as noted; "CCOH did not sign." Again the Appellants information was not posted and the Remittitur was sent.

7. Appellant sent an e-mail on 11-24-2015 concerning case 2015-001331 pointing out the pattern of mistakes which include Appeals 2015-000049 & 2015-001511 which were Appellants second time of submitting his concern about his mailed documents not being filed and again there wasn't any response about the ongoing pattern of mistakes.

8. On 12-3-15 Appellants Motion to Reinstate was filed for case 2015-001331, it stated; because of the following mistakes made by the Clerks Office that were questioned pointed out and mailed to the Clerks office on Oct. 13th 2015 and again emailed on Nov 24th and because of these mistakes Appellants 3 cases were dismissed.

9. NOTE; In this Motion is the "Concern Letter" exposing a pattern of mistakes during cases 2015-000049, 2015-001331 and 2015-001511. Also on 12-3-15 the Clerks Office sent a Deficiency letter stating Appellant didn't sign his Proof of Service for his

Motion to Reinstate and on 12-10-15 Appellant mailed his signed proof of service by Certified mail and it was signed as received by the Clerks Office, but again was never posted and then the Remittitur was sent because of this mistake. Exhibit I

10. On 1-7-16 Appellants E-mail posting in this case shows a copy of correspondence that was forwarded by Jenny Kitchings to Elizabeth Carter which was originally sent on 1-5-16 to Kitchings where Appellant responded to the Oct. 22 Deficiency letter and Appellant had mailed his signed Motion & Proof of Service and noted the ongoing situation about Appellant's information not being posted and also asked what procedure to follow concerning the Remittitur being sent because of the mistakes made by the Clerks Office and there wasn't any response about how to proceed or any explanation about their mistakes.

11. Appellant called Jenny Kitchings and asked her if she could call back today and Appellant called again at 4:53 and left another message explaining the urgency of her returning the call soon as possible. Appellant had to call again 2 days later and tries to explain to her he wanted to discuss this matter of unposted documents and some other issues. She said she apologizes for not returning the call and tells Appellant he will have to file a Motion to address his complaints about the Clerks Office and on Monday they would be mailing some information concerning this matter.

12. Posted Jan. 11th 2016 case 2015-000049, V. Claire Allen sent a letter stating the E-mail Appellant sent about his concern of missing documents does not reflect service on the other parties to the Appeal and any document filed with the court must be accompanied by proof of service. It also stated no further action will be taken because the Remittitur had already been sent. Appellant was not trying to file this concern with the

court and just wanted Jenny Kitchings to look into the matter. Pro se was just asking for some answers to explain why his mailed information was being lost, mishandled or how these mistakes being made and this was how she responded to the call.

13. Also the reason for the E-mail was because Jenny Kitchings, V. Claire Allen or Elizabeth Carter never responded to any of the Appellants questions of concerns even though the Motion to Reinstate that was filed on 12-3-2015 in case 2015-001331 did reflect service and requested a response and or explanation about their mistakes.

14. Jenny Kitchings basically told the Appellant he needed to officially file his complaint and this was after Appellant had already made a formal complaint that was filed and posted on Dec. 3rd 2015 as part of the Appellants Motion to Reinstate during Appeal 2015-001331.

15. This Motion included; APPELLANTS 2ND NOTICE OF CONCERN ABOUT MISSING MAILED FILINGS TO THE COURT which included 4 pages of mistakes and 8 Exhibits that did in fact reflect service.

16. The most disturbing and unanswered question concerning Appeal 2015 -001331 is that it exposes the apparent ongoing mistakes and what happened to the Appellants MUSC Relief of Judgment that was mailed on 9-24-15 (Exhibit F) that was in a large envelope containing 7 notebooks. Appellant states for a fact that not one letter he mailed to the Court of Administration was ever returned to him, not one.

17. Also a second letter was sent on Jan. 11th (correspondence) by V. Claire Allen addressed to Pro se for Appeal 2015-001331 which was stated by Jenny Kitchings; "If you intend to proceed with this Appeal pro se, the fact that you are not an attorney does not relieve you of the responsibility to perfect your Appeal in accordance with the

South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.” This is the Clerks office version of finally discussing their mistakes with the Appellant.

18. The Remittitur for this Appeal was sent on Nov. 18th 2015 and Appellant agrees that he has made simple mistakes and Appellant is glad he was reminded of his responsibilities. Therefore, the Court of Administration/Clerks Office should also perfect their responsibility's, beginning with the Clerks Office failure to send a third letter to the Respondent in case 2015-001511 that was also included in the Appellants concern about mistakes that was filed with Appellants Motion to Reinstate in case 2015-001331, which included the subject of the Clerks Office failing to respond to Appellant complaints and questions concerning his mailed documents.

19. On Monday Feb. 1st 2015 Appellant sent Jenny Kitchings an E-mail and asked her a very important question about Appeal 2015-001331 where Appellant had to file a Motion to Reinstate because of mistakes and again she did not respond. Two days later Appellant sends another E-mail and again she did not respond. 2 days later on Friday Feb. 5th Appellant Pro se received a second letter reminding him he had a responsibility to perfect his Appeal so at 4:29 Appellant called to speak with Jenny Kitchings and he was told she had left for the day.

20. Appellant sends a third E-mail later that day at 5:25 so Appellant could remind her that his question has a time issue because his Motion could be decided any day now and to also remind her that she also has responsibilities. Also at 4:08, Feb. 8th 2016 there still wasn't a response, so the following demonstrates the ongoing problem:


I just called for you today at 4:29 and they said you have already left. I E-mailed you on Monday and Wednesday concerning Appeal 2015-001331 with an important question that may have a time deadline to make a motion and you still haven't answered the question. I know I'm not an attorney as you have pointed out in a second letter that I received today and you stated "If you intend to proceed with this appeal pro se, the fact that you are not an attorney does not relieve you of the responsibility to perfect your appeal" Well, I do have 3 Appeals being mishandled within your offices and I assume since I am a tax paying citizen here in South Carolina that you could possibly perform your responsibilities since this is the second time you haven't responded to my questions of why my complaints aren't being addressed concerning your employees misplacing my mailed documents to your office which caused my cases to be dismissed. It is apparent that the reason you do not respond is because you don't have any respect for me because I'm not an attorney and/or you don't like me making complaints about your staff. If I'm wrong maybe you could address that and I've never been much for playing politics but if I did I guess I would go to the state house and see my elected brother in law who has an office right down the hall from Nikki Haley and ask him why can't a regular taxpayer like me get any respect? 21. Therefore Pro se Appellant feels he has been ignored, slighted & multiple mistakes were made in this matter and during the other 2 cases that do in fact reveal a pattern of mistakes. Specifically in this case, Appellant mailed his Designation of Matter to the Court of Administration and only because the Pro se called and questioned the perfection of the Clerks Office that it was revealed they again made a mistake and then it was posted on Oct 13th, 2016.

22. Also the Court of Administration/Clerks Office second mistake was when the Appellant had to sign his Designation of Matter and Proof of Service in this case and he properly mailed it on Oct 31st, 2015 and again it was never filed or posted.

Therefore Pro se, Appellant request the Honorable South Carolina Court Of Appeals to overrule or Vacate this Dismissal and Reinstate the Appeal. Thank you,

MOTION TO RE-INSTATE

Pro se, Appellant Jack Powell submits this Motion to Re-instate case 2015-001331 because of the following mistakes made by the Clerks office that was questioned and pointed out, then mailed to the Clerks office on Oct 13th - 2015 and again e-mailed on Nov. 24th and because of these mistakes Appellant's three cases have been dismissed.

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**APPELLANTS 2ND NOTICE OF CONCERN ABOUT MISSING
MAILED FILINGS TO THE COURT**

The reason I'm contacting you is because on several occasions I have mailed information concerning my cases 2015-49, 2015-1331 and 2015-001511. For some reason they may have been misplaced or lost because the info isn't being posted or responded to when I sent my first concern about this matter.

On Oct. 1st, 2015 Appellant mailed his request for leave to file out of time concerning Designation of Matter and on Oct. 12th the court filed Appellant had failed to send my Designation of Matter. On Oct 13th Appellant mailed his first letter about a concern about letters he had sent to the Clerks Office, that weren't posted. Earlier that day before Appellant had sent this concern letter he called about the Designation of Matter not being posted and Elizabeth Carter wasn't there, so another lady said she would help. (she didn't identify herself) She said for Appellant to hold on for a minute and then she got back on the phone and was basically talking out loud and said no, no, here it is and then it was posted Oct. 13th.

Appellant will demonstrate there is a pattern of unposted information forwarded to the Court of Administration and would like for your office to contact me soon as possible.

Case no. 2015-000049

1. On 8-24-15 Appellant was sent a letter that stated his Designation of Matter wasn't included.
2. Exhibit A. On Oct. 1st -15, Appellant purchased a money order and two stamps and mailed to the Court of Administration and to Attorney's Wall, Templeton and Haldrup for a motion to proceed out of time which included my Designation of Matter. This was written at top of the exhibit at the USPS for my records.
3. Posted on 10-12-15 and mailed is a letter stating Appellant failed to send Designation of Matter.
4. Posted on 10-13-15 and mailed Motion to Allow Late Filing Fee of Appellants Designation of Matter. (construed as a petition to reinstate the appeal) also; DESIGNATION FILED BY APPELLANT (motion pending).
5. Posted Nov. 18th, two letters sent about case being dismissed and Remittitur to Lower Court that should be stopped or revoked ? just like the Remittitur that was stopped after Appellant called and was told they would take care of it and they did.

6. Exhibit B. on Oct. 13 Appellant sent three letters of concern in one envelope of cases 2015-000049, 2015-001331 and 2015-001511 and Appellant was wanting to know why some letters/info weren't being posted and could they please let me know what had happened and what should be done. There never was a response and now cases are being dismissed because of this.
7. Posted on Oct. 22 and a letter was sent to Appellant stating I had not signed properly.
8. Exhibit C on Oct. 31 Appellant signed and returned to the Administration and as of Nov. 20th there wasn't anything posted.
9. On Nov. 24th Appellant e-mailed this second letter of concern along with Exhibits about the original letters of concern around 4:45 that afternoon to Jenny Kitchings.
10. On Nov. 30th at 1:54 Appellant called and asked to speak to Mrs. Kitchings and was told she would get her supervisor and Appellant stated no, I need to talk to Mrs. Kitchings about an e-mail I had sent her last week. She then stated she was at lunch and Appellant left a message asking her to please call me today and let Appellant know if she had received this e-mail because of my time left concerning two remittiturs.
11. At 4:53 Appellant called back because of the urgency involved and was told she was unavailable and Appellant left the same message.
12. At 4:55 Appellant called back to go ahead and discuss this with someone else and the telephone rang for three minutes and two seconds and now Appellant has a tighter situation because of this.
13. On Dec 1st Appellant called again at 1:39 and Jenny Kitchings apologized for not returning call and tells Appellant he has to file motions to enter his complaint about the clerks office.

Case no. 2015-001331

9. Posted On 7-23-15, Transcript Ordered.
10. Posted on 9-4-15, Transcript not received.
11. Exhibits D & E is a letter Appellant didn't receive from reporter Ruth Mott and was resent after Appellant had made a complaint to Desiree Allen/court reporters, about her not responding.
12. Exhibits F, on Oct. 1st Appellant called for Elizabeth Carter and asked why wasn't my Relief

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of Judgement that was mailed on Sept. 24th, not posted?

13. Exhibits B, D, E & G on Oct. 13th Appellant mailed his concern about un-posted information and included in the envelope was my explanation of my doubt of the court reporter, Ruth Mott's accuracy of the cost she had submitted to me. Also Pro se asked for a procedure to follow or a procedure the court may follow to get to the bottom of her improper request. I never got a response.

14. Posted Oct 22. A letter stating Appellant must provide that he had made arrangements and Appellant called and explained his letter of concern and was told they would take care of it and that is why again Appellant did not respond to the Oct 22nd letter because of what he was told they would do again, take care of it and now Appellant's case has been dismissed??.

CASE: 2015-001511

15. Exhibit H, on 8-8-15 Appellant mailed his proof of service for Motion to Proceed In forma pauperis that was in the letter filed on Sept. 3rd that Appellant failed to do this. APPELLANT MAILED LETTER!

Appellant called and asked for Elizabeth Carter and she wasn't there and the lady that answered said she would help me and never identified herself. Appellant had called originally about another case and asked her was it true that Appellant had a year to appeal this since he was told earlier in another case he had a year to Appeal. Appellant thought the case was dismissed and he had a year to do something about it. She asked the case no. and she said Appellant had one more day to send the Form letter to stop the Remittitur from being sent. Appellant explained to her he had sent the letter on 8-8-15 Exhibit I and Appellant had a receipt from the USPS to help prove it but apparently the clerks office did not have it. Appellant told her it's about 4:00 and there was no way he could put all this together then drive to the library and type it up and then make it to the post office before 5:00 and mail it overnight, especially since Appellant's wife was gone in our car. Appellant told her I don't know what to do and I guess I'm really messed up now because of the USPS not delivering the letter (it was never returned to Appellant along with any other letters from the Court of Administration) and it looks like Appellant's case is going to be dismissed because of the sorry post office. The lady said I don't know what to tell you.

But now Appellant thinks the letter that was sent was there all the time, but what bothers Appellant most about this is about a week later Appellant found out he could have sent it electronically from the library, 262 (A) (2) and she had the opportunity and should have told the Pro se he could do this and it would have not been giving him advice but a procedure that is used by attorneys.

16. Posted Sept 3rd This Matter is Dismissed and Appellant has failed to provide the Notice of Appeal filing fee and I never received anything stating Appellant had been denied his request to proceed In forma Pauperis. Also Appellant sent the letter and proof of service on 8-8-15. So what legal standing and/or procedure can a Pro se take or is this something that the Clerks office needs to fix, please respond. Thank you, Jack Powell at carolineschair@gmail.com or (843) 952-4762

Therefore Appellant submits this motion to reinstate case 2015-001331, Medical University of South Carolina v. Jack Powell because Appellant mailed his form letter that the transcript was ordered, mailed a letter of concern explaining why the transcript hadn't been paid for and was later told by the clerks office they would take care of it and because of ongoing mistakes made by the clerks office.

I have also enclosed the actual copy of my Form 12 that was originally sent on 10-12-15 after Appellant realized he had accidentally posted the wrong address and corrected the mistake. But, again Appellant made the same mistake when putting together this second concern letter with old copies before Appellant e-mailed to Jenny Kitchings and noticed this today before submitting this Motion to Reinstate.



This is Appellant Jack Powell and I'm reporting that I received a response by reporter Ruth Mott on August 2nd for Marshland Communities and MUSC which stated; Upon review of the records, I estimate your transcript to be approximately 40 pages at a cost of \$135.05. Then the case for Marshland was dismissed and I made the request again just for MUSC and asking for the exact amount of pages. On September 30th in her response just for MUSC she stated; The transcript is 40 pages at a cost of \$135.05.

On July 22nd I received a response from Reporter Karen Anderson requesting \$21.50 for the transcript where I spoke 13 times covering only 2 pages in case 2015-000049 and during this MUSC 2015-001331 hearing I was only allowed to speak three sentences before being cut off by Judge Dennis and him then granting MUSC Summary Judgment. Therefore the cases were basically the same amount or less and I'm questioning the accuracy of this estimate the reporter has made and I'm also requesting the administration to look into this or possibly make a suggestion or a procedure for a Pro se to follow to get to the bottom of this.
