My Name is Dwayne Childs #325820 and im housed at Lee Corr Inst. I recieved a notice from my Appellate Attorney Wanda Carter stating that she filed an Anders brief informing me that my case has not merit. Wanda Carter sent me another letter stating that she no longer wants to to Represent me in this appeal process. Im asking could the court of Appeals remove her as being my attorney and assign me someone else, because according to *Evitts vs Lucey* im entitled to a proper Representation from my Appellate Attorney, and Ms Carter hasnt done anything in my favor in this appeal process. I have a clear cut Miranda Violation in which the judge allowed statements in, and didnt have a miranda form signed by me, no audio or video proving i agreed to talk or even made any statements. The judge only went on the word of the officer and that violates the Procedure of Miranda and Wanda Carter didnt even address this issue that my trial lawyer preserved. I have an Issue about the Reliability of the CI and the fact that the CI didnt testify, because The US Supreme Court has ruled in cases in favor of the defendant to Confront CI's. *US vs Price (1986)* If an informant was active in an alleged sale of drugs and not a mere tipster, the CI is material

to the case, denial of disclosure of his identity, denies defendant a fair trial requiring reversal.

US Const Amend 677 Sct at 627, fundamental requirements of fairness where the disclosure of an informers identity or of the contents of his communications is relevant and helpful to the defense, or an accused or essential to a fair determination of a case. the privilege must give way in these situations, the trial court may require disclosure, and if the government with holds the info dismiss the action. In *McLaurin vs NC* 484. f2d (4th cir 1973) in *McLaurin* the Court held that disclosure of the informants identity is required where the informant is an actual participant, particularly where he helps set up the Criminal Occurrence. Therefore the factors show that the prosecutor is not entitled to withhold the identity of the informant. The judge ignored this motion as well and i informed McCartney that i have newly discovered evidence about an officer in my case that testified at my trial stating he found drugs and money in my home, but i have documents to prove that this officer lied to his Superiors about taking funds and giving it to a CI that he was informed to stay away from her (How can i determine if the CI wasn't paid to say what he supposedly said when reflecting on this officers behavior?) and also evidence tampering and forging documents. (How can i determine

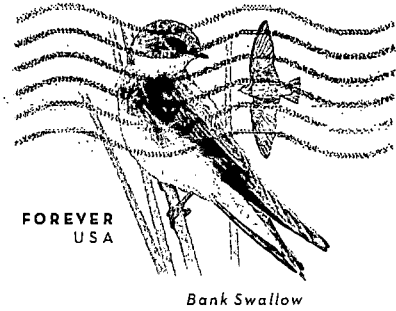
