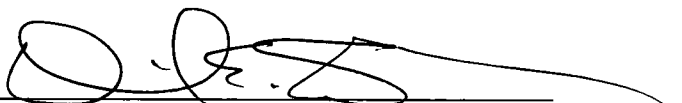
EXECUTION NOTICE
