I am writing to you in response to the letter I received informing me that I failed to provide sufficient explanation for my appeal and that the matter had been dismissed.

I have not had an opportunity to go to the law library here yet to look up rule 203 to see what is required or when and how or why. I do believe I should have received a more detailed explanation as to why my appeal was dismissed. Also I fail to see how a lay person with little to no knowledge of the law or of the necessary legal procedures can be expected to provide a sound legal basis or argument for their appeal. Furthermore I fail to see how my claims of my fourth, fifth, sixth, fourteenth amendment rights being violated and that my guilty plea was the product of fear and coercion and therefore not willingly and freely given was not or is not sufficient cause to have this matter looked into.

I do hereby give you notice that I wish to appeal the summary dismissal of my case. If necessary I want this matter and will make all necessary efforts to bring this matter to the attention of the South Carolina Supreme Court to appeal my conviction.
